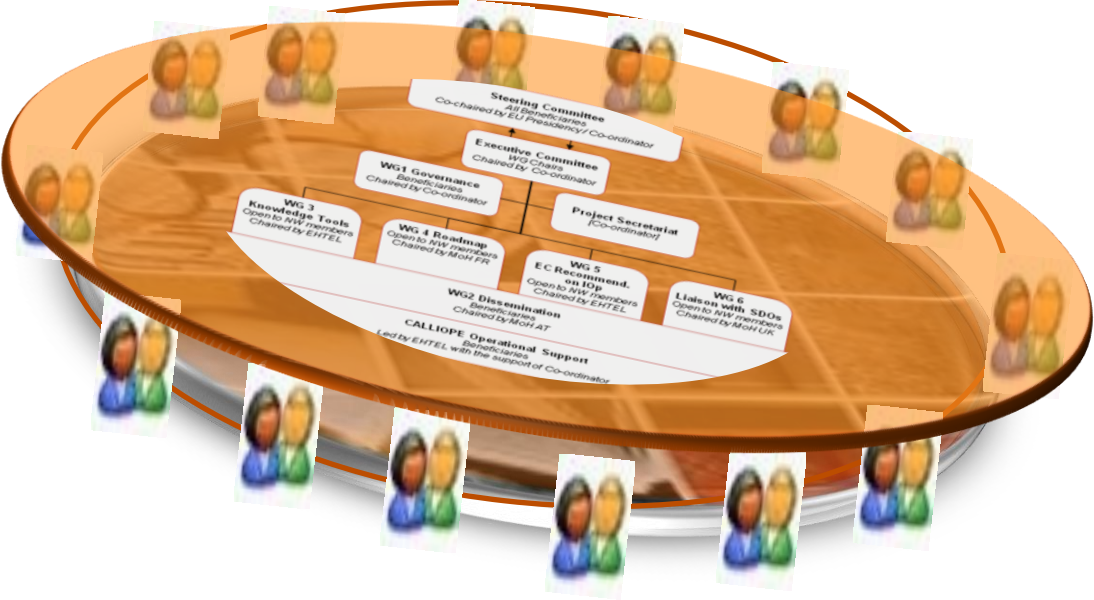

The Rhetorical Triangle

Ethos, Pathos, Logos

- **Ethos**= an appeal to integrity of character is the source credible?
- **pathos**: = an appeal to emotions – does it relate to me?
- **Logos** = an appeal to reason – is it scientifically robust?
