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# Telemedicine enabling Seamless Services in the Personal Sphere:

## – Common approach of the RENEWING HeALTH Pilots –

- 8000 patients in 18 parallel pilots in 9 European regions
- Telemedicine Services for three chronic conditions: Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease (CVD), Chronic Obstructive Lung Disease (COPD)
- Randomised Controlled Trials & Multidimensional Evaluation („MAST“)
- Common primary and similar secondary outcomes within the disease clusters, e.g. HBA1c (Diabetes), SF36v2 (HR – QoL)

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# Disease Related Clusters

## Cluster 1 - 800

### *Diabetes*

Medium-term health coaching and life-long monitoring

## Cluster 2 - 900

### *Diabetes*

Life-long monitoring

## Cluster 3 - 200

### *Diabetes*

Ulcer monitoring

## Cluster 4 - 420

### *COPD*

Short-term follow-up after hospital discharge

## Cluster 5 - 800

### *COPD*

Life-long monitoring

## Cluster 6 - 480

### *CVD*

Medium-term health coaching and life-long monitoring

## Cluster 7 - 310

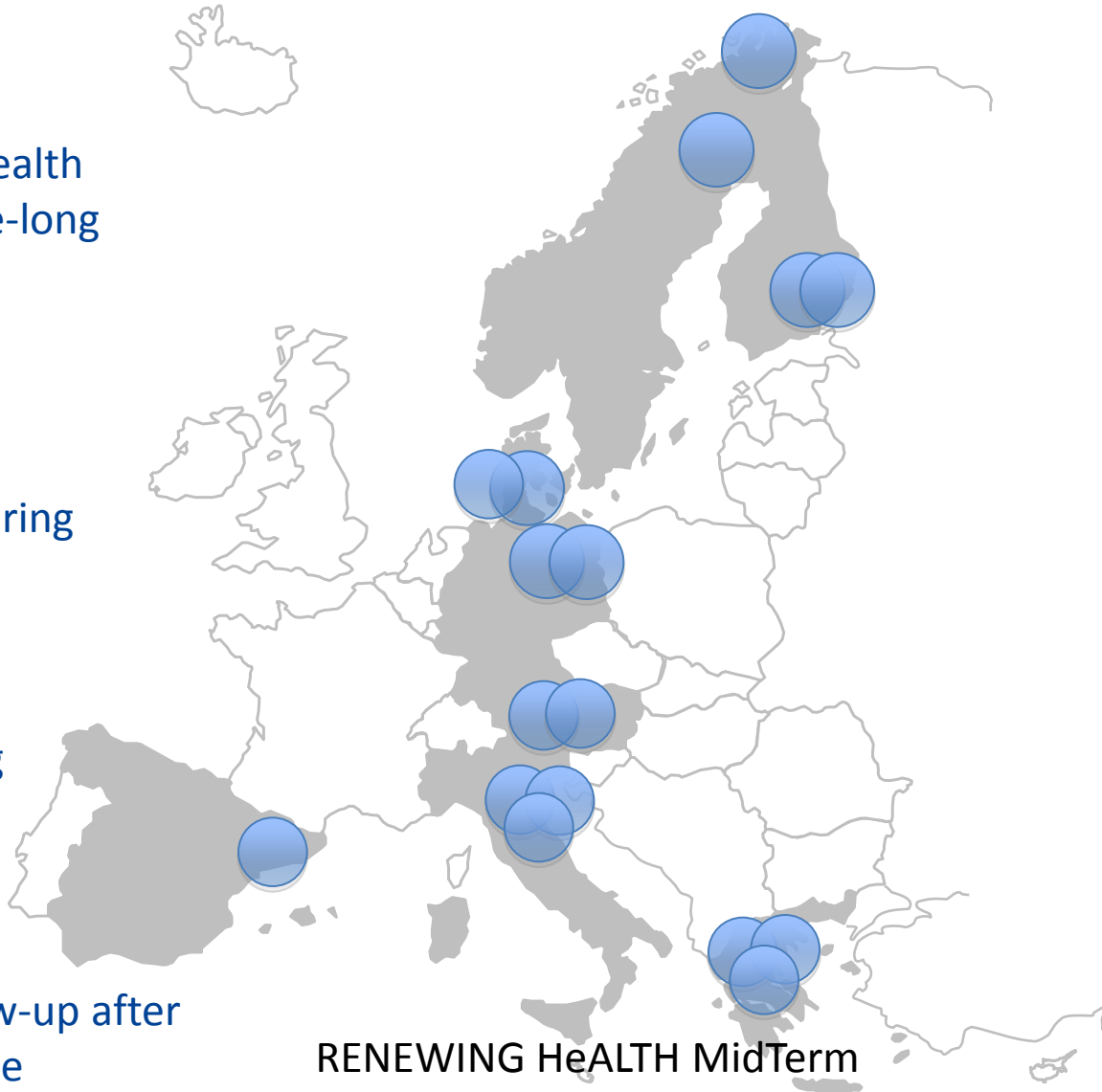
### *CVD*

Remote monitoring of Congestive Heart Failure

## Cluster 8 - 1850

### *CVD*

Remote monitoring of implantable cardiac devices
